It is with regret that we inform you that 22625992 Pte Albert William CAMDEN died on 15 November 2017 at Hereford Hospital. Albert enlisted as a National Serviceman on 3 January 1952 into 1st Battalion The Worcestershire Regiment. He served in 'C' Company and was posted to Malaya during the 'Emergency'. Albert was discharged on 20 December 1953. In civilian life Albert worked for British Gas and later took up work as a landscape gardener. He also had a keen interest in antiques and was very proud of the horses he kept. He will be remembered for hosting events at his home on Crumpton Hill where he would set up a large basher and put Malayan place names out on the local roads to hold a reunion, providing food and drink for those that had served in Malaya and friends from Worcester Branch. Albert's Funeral will be held on Tuesday 5 December 2017 at 1430 hours at Worcester Crematorium, Tintern Avenue, Astwood Road, Worcester. WR3 8HA. Standards, Bugle and Association members welcome.
